

The supplies listed here are needed to support your child's success in the classroom. All supplies are required and should be sent with your child on the first day of school. Supplies may need to be replenished throughout the school year.

Assignment notebooks are provided to every student in grades 2 through 8. Additional notebooks will be supplied if needed. The cost of the notebook is covered in the Curriculum Fee.
